From Flemington and PA: Rt. 202 North, go about seven miles beyond the Flemington Circle, take the jug-handle “U-Turn” using Whiton road (just after a Getty Station) to go South on Rt. 202 briefly, then make the right towards “STANTON” onto Pleasant Run Road, the farm under 1 mile on the left.
From Somerville, Rt. 287, Rt. 206N, Rt. 202N: Take Rt. 202 South for approx. 7 miles after the Somerville exchange, make the right towards “STANTON” onto Pleasant Run Road, the farm is under 1 mile on the left.
From Rt. 22 or 78: Take Rt. 523 South (Exit 24 off Rt. 78) through Whitehouse, go several miles, make the left onto Rt. 629 (Pleasant Run Rd), the farm is three miles on the right

1. Please fax entries to (908)-832-6402, or phone to (908)-832-7402. Please use a completed entry blank and show ALL necessary proof of recording for every OWNER, RIDER, TRAINER and HORSE! An incomplete entry blank cannot be issued a back number.
2. Post entries will be accepted at no charge, but early entries are most appreciated.
3. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
4. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
5. The Briarwood Farm Horse Show, Briarwood Farm Inc., the Committee, or the property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
6. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
7. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
8. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
9. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
10. Ties for first place will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points, ribbons and prizemoney.
11. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds.
12. Horses must enter entire division to be eligible for prizemoney.
13. Prizemoney and Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office. Please allow one-half hour for processing.
14. All pets must be leashed.
15. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
16. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management by the steward.
17. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be forwarded to the USEF for collection.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ATTN EXHIBITORS: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but no limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooter, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

REGARDING MEASUREMENTS: A veterinarian will be present at these two shows in May & June. Please take advantage of the vet being present, and make every effort to get any animal measured that might need a permanent measurement card at any point in its career!


